

NOTICE REGARDING SETTLEMENT AND INDIA INVESTIGATION
(Allscripts (India) LLP employees)

There have existed certain disputes between Allscripts Healthcare, LLC (“Allscripts”), Mahathi Software Pvt., Ltd. (“Mahathi India”), and Andor Health, LLC (“Andor”), which relate to the HealthGrid business. After reasonable and diligent review, the undersigned agrees that to the best of its knowledge after its review, Jaydeep Madhukar Wakankar had no involvement in or responsibility for the matters at issue in the Indian Proceedings, and further agrees to dismiss the offences in the matters at issue in the Indian Proceedings, which include all proceedings arising out of or related to any such complaint, including any investigation, criminal charge, civil or criminal suit or proceeding, including and without limiting the breadth and scope of the definition of Indian Proceedings, the investigation and all activities and proceedings associated with the FIR assigned number CR. 91/2021, the Charge-sheet dated September 20, 2021, any additional or supplemental Charge-sheet, the case captioned Cyber Crime Police Station, Visakhapatnam v. Jaydeep Madhukar Wakankar & Ors, CC No. 3515/2021 currently pending in the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Visakhapatnam (“Case CC No. 3515/2021”), and all proceedings initiated by Defendants before Andhra Pradesh High Court, or interventions, applications, or petitions filed by Defendants in connection with Indian Allscripts Entities and Employees Proceedings.

By way of background on May 18, 2018, Allscripts entered into a Statement of Work with Mahathi Software Pvt., Ltd. (“Mahathi India”) (“2018 SOW”) to enable Mahathi India to provide software services for HealthGrid. The HealthGrid solution is a part of the FollowMyHealth business owned by Allscripts. On May 14, 2021, Allscripts provided written notice to Mahathi India that Allscripts did not intend to extend or renew the 2018 SOW and that it would allow the 2018 SOW to expire by its terms on May 17, 2021. Between May 14, 2021 and May 21, 2021 there were actions taken in and to the HealthGrid platform (the “May 2021 Events”). These actions gave rise to claims by and between Allscripts and Mahathi India against each other, as well as against certain employees of Allscripts.

Mahathi India and its representatives initiated an investigation in Visakhapatnam, India, pursuant to a First Information Report (“FIR”) assigned number CR. 91/2021, which resulted in a Charge-sheet being issued on September 20, 2021. That case was captioned Cyber Crime Police Station, Visakhapatnam v. Jaydeep Madhukar Wakankar & Ors, CC No. 3515/2021 currently pending in the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Visakhapatnam (all complaints, FIRs, claims, and other filings by any Party, whether criminal or civil in nature, are collectively referred by as the “India Investigation”).

Allscripts, Andor and Mahathi India have each conducted a review of the May 2021 Events. The parties have resolved all issues in the Litigation and the India Investigation and determined to dismiss the offences with those matters. After reasonable and diligent review, Allscripts, Andor and Mahathi India each state that to the best of its understanding:

- Jaydeep Madhukar Wakankar is not an employee of Allscripts Healthcare, LLC.
- Jaydeep Madhukar Wakankar had no knowledge of or involvement in the work Mahathi India did for Allscripts pursuant to the 2018 SOW and was not involved in the drafting of and work performed under the 2018 SOW or any other contract between the entities.
- Jaydeep Madhukar Wakankar had no involvement in the May 2021 Events or other matters at issue in the India Investigation.
- To the best of our knowledge, there is not now, nor has there at any point been, any basis for a Look Out Circular (“LOC”) to be issued against Jaydeep Madhukar Wakankar.

Accordingly, after reasonable and diligent investigation, the undersigned parties have absolved Jaydeep Madhukar Wakankar of any wrongdoing related to the allegations in the Litigation and Indian Investigation, including those related to the May 2021 Events.



