SECTION 1:

Customer/Client shall not use, or allow or permit any person to use, the Meridian Software or the Product Data or the information obtained from using the Meridian Software or the Product Data for Clinical Registration Purposes.

SECTION 2:

“Clinical Registration Purposes” means the purposes of creating a register or providing any information to a register or prospective register the objective of which is to do all or any or any combination of the following in order to:

- 2.1 Establish how long joint replacements last;
- 2.2 Provide feedback to orthopaedic surgeons and teams to enable them to optimise their clinical practice;
- 2.3 Promote open publication of performance of implants to improve awareness;
- 2.4 Define the current practice of orthopaedic surgeons;
- 2.5 Provide feedback on implant performance to regulatory authorities;
- 2.6 Provide feedback to manufacturers about the clinical performance of implants;
- 2.7 Monitor the comparative performance of hospitals and clinics;
- 2.8 Facilitate the identification of individual patients who have received an implant should there be a requirement for urgent clinical review;

SECTION 3:

Customer/Client acknowledges that:

- 3.1 Meridian Software is to be used to identify possible implants or joint replacements that could be used in an operation;
